Prices & Activities List

We offer half-day, full-day, and overnight programs. And hey, if you want to stay longer, fill your boots!

**All prices listed are before tax:

Most Popular Programs

- 1. Half-day All for \$12 per student / \$6 per leader
- 5 hours of programming (i.e. 9am-2pm)
- Up to 8 different activities of your choice
- Students and leaders must provide own bag lunch

2. Full-Day - \$20 per student / \$10 per leader

- 8 hours of programming (i.e. 9am-5pm)
- Up to 10 different activities of your choice
- Students and leaders must provide own bag lunch
- Supper meal provided by the camp

3. Full Day and Overnight - \$40 per student / \$20 per leader

- 14 hours of programming (i.e. 9am-10pm)
- Up to 12 different activities of your choice
- Full lunch, supper, snack, and breakfast

NEW THIS YEAR

We tried a new model last season wherein students could choose more freely which activities they wanted to participate in. This worked great for some, but we have recognized that it may not work for students that need a little more structure. In previous years we have offered a rotation of activities that every student *had* to participate in, and that, at times, wasn't enjoyable for kids that didn't want to do that particular activity; and it also proved to be difficult to get everyone through each rotation. So this year we are going to strike a balance! We need you to provide us with an idea of what activities you would like your students to experience and we will build a scheduled rotation of activities, and do our very best to ensure that each student gets a chance to try each one. For those students that don't want to participate in a particular activity we will provide options that teachers/leaders can do with their kids that are self-guided. For example, if a student is afraid to ride our zipline they could chose to opt out and try the bouncy castle with the accompaniment of their leader while the other students carry on at the zipline.

Another change we have made is we will no longer be offering lunch meals in our half and full day program options. I know this may come as a disappointment to some, but we would like to be able to offer an affordable fee to our customers, and for years we have been swallowing losses on food service provided in these programs. Moving forward we will be able to devote more resources to programming and supervision for your students. If having meals provided was something your students looked forward to we can certainly provide the service at an additional, and affordable rate.

OTHER INFO

Tuck Shop (Canteen) will be open during the lunch break for anyone who wants a treat. Cost for tuck items is not included in student or leader pricing and students will need to bring their own money for this option.

Teachers are responsible to divide your students into groups before arriving at camp. Group size is max of 8 students for 1 leader. The group leaders are responsible for the students in their care and for taking the students to the camp activities.

We will provide each teacher/leader with a Camp Map showing all activities & their locations on site. You will also receive the camp rules, schedule, and other important information.



Rules & Regulations

- 1. Smoking is not permitted on the grounds of Camp Shiktehawk.
- 2. The use or possession of alcohol or non-prescription drugs is prohibited on camp property.
- 3. The use of profanity is prohibited on camp property.
- 4. Do not enter the cabins or rooms without the permission of someone who is staying there.
- 5. Use of the Pool and Waterfront (Beach & reservoir) is permitted only under the supervision of our lifeguard.
- 6. Please supervise all children using the playground equipment. All other camp programs equipment will be used only under the supervision of a Shiktehawk Staff member.
- 7. No water or food fights will be tolerated inside any buildings.
- 8. Guests are not permitted in the kitchen area unless they are part of the cooking team. Please ask if you need something.
- 9. For those staying in our accommodations, certain accommodations will be designated for MALES only, the rest for FEMALES only. Some facilities are available for married couples; otherwise members of the opposite sex are not permitted in each other's cabins or washrooms. This rule is for reasons for privacy and is without exception.
- 10. Towels and bedding are not provided. Towels and other personal toiletries should NOT be left in the washrooms so that maintenance personnel can properly clean washrooms.
- 11. Damages and/or excessive cleaning as a result of misuse of property or equipment will be billed to the contact person at a rate of \$20.00/hour plus material expenses.

Important Notes

A \$250.00+HST confirmation deposit is required a month before the date of arrival, accompanied by this Rental Agreement Form and the completed activity list. Payment and submission of forms can be made by mail, in person, or through our website: www.campshiktehawk.com

In the event your group/organization cancels prior to two (2) weeks before the date of your event, you will be permitted to transfer the Confirmation Deposit to another date within one year. If your group/organization cancels any time after two (2) weeks prior to the scheduled event, we will retain the Confirmation Deposit - the deposit will not be transferable or refundable.

As the Camp has no way to monitor the leaders, we ask that Leaders (and Parents) pay the school directly NOT the Camp, to avoid any confusion.

Minimum Group Size: 15 persons

We will accommodate smaller groups, however, the total rental fee will not be less than the \$250.00+HST Confirmation Deposit.***

Upon arrival at Camp Shiktehawk - Please go to the office to pay the balance of your rental fees. Please have accurate numbers of leaders and students on hand.
